The PITTSFIELD LIONS CLUB and the CITY OF PITTSFIELD will once again sponsor Pike County Pig Days. This year's event will be held on **July 10 & 11**. Last year was successful for the Lion's Club, due in part to our many and varied vendors. We wish to cordially invite you to join us in making this well established festival a wonderful place for locals and visitors to shop, be entertained, eat great food, and have lots of fun.

Set up will be on the evening of Thursday, July 9th and Friday morning (if necessary). Upon arrival please come to the check-in booth. The check-in booth will be staffed on Thursday evening 5-9pm and again on Friday morning at 8am. Placement on the grounds will be dependent on your need for electrical outlets. **Along with the electrical needs, the date that the forms are received, determines the placement on the grounds.**

Temporary parking around the square is allowed for unloading and loading only. Then you will be required to move your vehicles (car, trucks, campers, and trailers) to designated vendor parking areas just off the square. **This policy will be strictly enforced.** Parking near the square is for your customer's convenience.

You may put signs on your assigned space but nowhere else on the courthouse square.

The Committee **reserves the right to refuse the disbursement** of any merchandise that we consider unsafe and/or inappropriate for our festival. This includes, but is not limited to: **guns, swords, bows/arrows and other projectiles, silly string, pop caps, and disappearing ink.** We appreciate your cooperation.

Please keep the "Pig Day" theme in mind as you plan for this event. Anything "piggy" would be a plus. Have your tables covered attractively and to the ground and store all boxes and cartons under tables. **No pets are allowed on the courthouse grounds.**
