Pike County Little League has been serving our area since 1954. It started as a dream to provide boys and girls in our area a place to play organized ball. Now, 63 years later, we are dreaming and planning for the future of PCLL.

By adding turf to the infield of the facility in Pittsfield, we will be able to expand practice opportunities for our local teams, host tournaments to draw others to our area and make the facility available for high school softball programs in our area to use when their facilities are too wet to play on. This could be huge for our area!

In addition to turfing the field, we are also going to add coverings to the seating areas and replace the backstop. Estimated total cost of the project is \$175,000. While that may seem like a huge number, and it is, we feel that as a community, we can make an investment in the future of our youth and community that will have a great return.
