Welcome to the Pike County Health Department Dental Clinic!

What is the Dental Clinic?

The Pike County Health Department Dental Clinic provides dental health care to eligible children and adults, including pregnant women. Care is provided by a dentist and staff.

Am I eligible to use the Dental Clinic?

Families must be financially eligible to use the services of the Dental Clinic. Proof of income is required at the first visit and will be renewed every six months. Public Aid / Medicaid / All Kids recipients must show their card at each visit. Families who have private dental insurance will be referred to another provider.

How do I get treatment?

Appointments can be made by calling the clinic at 285-5311. Written parental consent is required for all children under the age of 18. Some services can be provided on a “walk-in” basis , if schedule allows.

What if I have to cancel an appointment?

All appointments must be cancelled 24 hours prior to the scheduled date and time. After three failed appointments without 24 hour notice, patients will not be seen for 1 year from the last missed appointment.

What are the fees for services?

Only Illinois Public Aid / Medicaid and All Kids cards are accepted. For children only, minimal fees are charged if not covered by Public Aid.

Where is the clinic located?

The clinic is located at the corner of Franklin & Adams Street in Pittsfield.
