Pike County, Illinois

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION:

Pike County is strategically located in West-Central Illinois, nestled between the Mississippi and Illinois Rivers.

Distance to: St. Louis - 95 miles; Springfield - 72 miles; Chicago - 275 miles; Kansas City - 225 miles.

Pike County is fifth in size of the 102 counties in Illinois.

TRANSPORTATION:

Served by Interstate 72, U.S. 54 and 36, State highways 96, 100, 104, 106 and 107.

Interstate 72 passes through Pike County leading to Quincy, Illinois and Hannibal, Missouri to the west and Springfield, Illinois to the east.

The Pittsfield Penstone Municipal Airport is owned and managed by the City of Pittsfield. It is located one mile north of Pittsfield and has a 4,000 foot asphalt runway. Services: Courtesy car rentals, catering, pickup and delivery, pilots' lounge and 24-hour self-serve fuel using MasterCard or Visa.

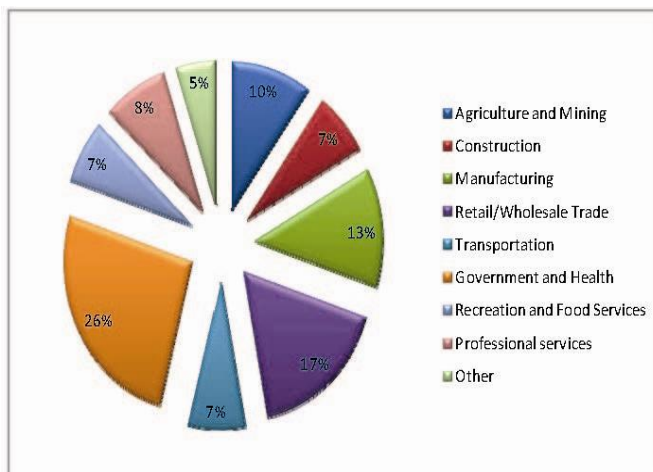
Quincy Regional Airport is 45 miles northwest of Pittsfield and Springfield's Capital airport is 70 miles east. Both offer commercial service to St. Louis and Chicago.

Four interstate and intrastate carriers service the Pike County area.

Rail service is provided by: KANSAS CITY SOUTHERN RAILWAY at Pearl; NORFOLK SOUTHERN RAILWAY at Valley City.

Several river terminals line the 65 miles of river bordering Pike County.
